

How to make a customized prototype for resin tableware?

PROTOTYPING PHASE

- 1. Send us a photograph or drawing of the piece you want to reproduce, specifying the size, capacity, etc. (it can be a scale reproduction), with this description tell us all kind of details and characteristics you want like color, finish, logos, etc.
- 2. We will make an estimate according to your model. In this budget will be included the price of the prototype and its mold, as well as the price of the pieces to produce.
- 3. Once the quotation is accepted, we will proceed to the realization of the first model and mold. We will send you this model for your approval.
- 4. We can make small changes without cost, but always adjusting to the descriptions given by you in the beginning and those changes that we see necessary to comply with aesthetic requirements such as color etc.
- 5. These changes will be adjusted in the final prototype to achieve the desired capacity or function, in case of cups or fitting parts.
- 6. The mold is for your exclusive use for a period of 2 years: up to 40 parts can be generated from a single mold. The minimum number of pieces that can be produced for the first production is 24 pieces. For more than 40 pieces, a new mold will have to be made again, but not the model (prototype) which will be a unique product.

MODELING PHASE

This process usually takes about 30 days.

PAINTING PHASE

- 1. The pieces are hand painted with a finish designed for food contact.
- 2. We apply different types of finish, depending on the piece to be made, but they are usually details that are left to your choice.
